Do you pay VAT on energy?

Both households and businesses pay VAT on the energy they buy, although at different rates. But what rate do they pay exactly? The standard VAT rate in the UK is 20%. However, domestic gas and electricity are charged at a reduced VAT rate of 5%.

What is the VAT rate on energy bills?

Your VAT rate on energy bills depends on your usage and business setup. It could be 5% or 20%, but many self-employed people are incorrectly charged. VAT is charged on most goods and services in the UK, and energy is no exception. The standard VAT rate is 20%, but for qualifying electricity and gas usage, this reduces to a 5% VAT rate.

What if my energy bill is below 5% VAT?

If your usage falls below these levels, your supplier should automatically apply the 5% VAT rate to your bills--even if the property is classified as commercial. If your usage is below the threshold but you're being charged 20%, you may be able to claim a refund going back up to 4 years. You'll be charged the standard 20% VAT rate on your energy if:

Is electricity subject to VAT?

Electricity Electricity supplied for a qualifying use (read section 3) is subject to the reduced rate. Supplies of not more than an average rate of 33 kilowatt hours per day, 1,000 kilowatt hours per month, of electricity to one customer at any one of the customer's premises are subject to VAT at the reduced rate.

The cost of the total supply is the total charge (excluding VAT) made to the customer (i.e. the total value of the supply of installing the energy-saving materials).
